SUSAN BOYLE

When she first took the stage in TV show *Britain's Got Talent*, it seemed Susan Boyle would be written off by judges and audience alike as a middle-aged woman with delusional dreams of stardom. But her performance of "I Dreamed a Dream" from *Les Miserables* left everyone stunned. She may have come second place on the show but Boyle's debut album *I Dreamed a Dream* topped the Christmas sales charts in eight countries.

The album is a showcase for Boyle's

amazing voice, notable for its clarity of diction and warmth, and

her ability to adapt to many different musical genres. Highlights are her renditions of Arthur Hamilton's "Cry Me a River" and of the Rolling Stones classic "Wild Horses".

I Dreamed a Dream proves Boyle is more than just a fleeting sensation – she's a genuine talent worth listening to.



Mariah Carey

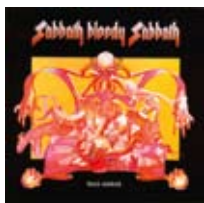
With a range spanning five octaves and an ability to hit notes in the whistle register, Mariah Carey has always been famous for her vocal acrobatics. But the singing on her 12th album, *Memoirs of an Imperfect Angel*, is some of her most subdued – and her music is stronger for it. With the trills kept to a minimum, Carey's songs feel warmer and more personal.



Johann Sebastian Bach

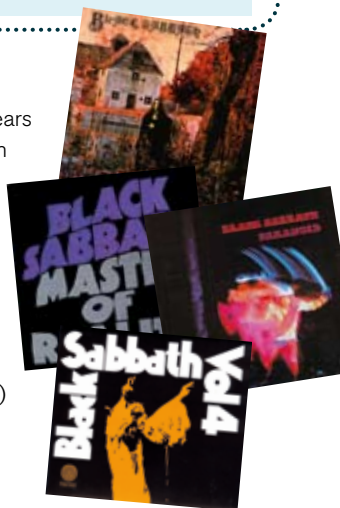
Bach's **Brandenburg Concertos** are widely regarded as some of the finest music of the Baroque era. Yet it is likely Bach himself never heard his seminal pieces performed. Bach gifted the concertos to the Margrave of Brandenburg, but the works remained untouched until more than a century later. On this album Bach's concertos are performed magnificently by John Eliot Gardiner and the English Baroque Soloists.

SPOTLIGHT: BLACK SABBATH



Despite getting very little radio play over the years because their songs are about apocalypse, death and destruction, Black Sabbath have managed to sell more than 15 million records in the United States alone. The band, who formed in 1969, were deemed pioneers of heavy metal – and many of today's biggest metal

bands, including Metallica, Slipknot, Pantera and Megadeth, cite Black Sabbath as one influencing them. We've got five of Black Sabbath's best albums (from the period when Ozzy Osbourne was their frontman) on board this month.



FLIGHT OF THE CONCHORDS



The second album by Wellington oddballs Jemaine Clement and Bret McKenzie, aka Flight of the Conchords, is a hilarious follow-up to their self-titled debut album and Grammy Award-winning EP *The Distant Future*. *I Told You I Was Freaky* is made up of songs from the second season of their hit HBO TV show, and is packed with the Conchords' trademark offbeat humour. Hit single "Hurt Feelings" is a gangsta-rap send-up about wounded pride ("Some people say that rappers are invincible/We're vincible")



and the pair's spoof of Sting classic "Roxanne" (called "You Don't Have to Be a Prostitute" – addressed to Clement) is parody at its finest.

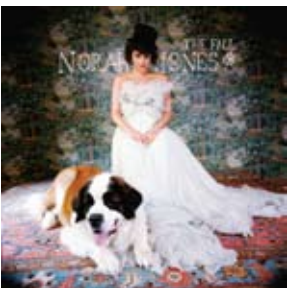

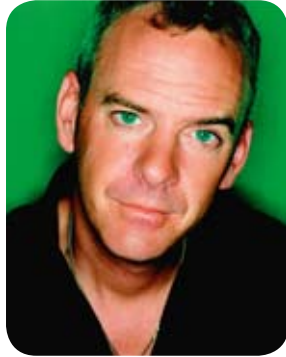


